## **Bring Your Own Device**

SEHS has a **Bring Your Own Device** program where all students are required to arrange their own computer/tablet to use at school to undertake their classroom work. Lockers are provided for all students to secure their device when not in use.

As a school, we have not identified specific laptops or tablets for purchase as we acknowledge some families may already have the appropriate devices at home.

We would, however, highly recommend a Windows device equipped with the following:

- 8 hour battery life
- 8GB of RAM minimum
- 16GB of RAM recommended
- 13-15 inch screen
- 128GB storage
- Intel i3 or AMD Ryzen 3 (minimun) Intel i5, Intel Evo or AMD Ryzen 7 is recommended
- Windows 11
- Headphone port, USB C Port

We DO NOT recommend the purchase of a Chromebook or MACBOOK, due to frequent incompatibility with teaching and learning programs at SEHS.

For families eligible for school-card, SEHS has a long-term loan program. Once enrolment has been confirmed, families will have the opportunity to apply for a device for 2025.



## Google Classroom

Google Classroom is designed to help teachers and students communicate, collaborate. manaae assignments online, and stay organised.

Google Classroom is part of the Google Apps for Education suite. Students at SEHS can access Google Classroom using their Edpass login details.

Google Classroom provides students the ability to create, organise, retain and submit their assignments. It also allows them to be able to access lesson assignment details content. and communicate with their teacher. With home internet, students can access this support 24/7 – either on site at SEHS or at home.
